Comments	<input type="text" value="I strongly object to this development. The impact on Pallinghurst mature woodland, the surrounding villages, quiet lanes and people's lives would be catastrophic. Vast CD&E recycling and wash plant machinery will not cope in this location. The principles of sustainability do not work in this case. Any extraction and recycling plant of this nature that exudes extensive CO2 and dust emissions needs to be located for easy accessability for the economics to work. This does not take into consideration the depletion of natural resources which maintains an ecological balance. Animal species will be lost. Re-location and 'fencing-in' of some animal species as outlined, is a temporary fix that is unsustainable. This Greenfield Site is wholly unacceptable for this development which will alter the character of the area far beyond the 30 year term stated for the duration of this business, financial venture to which I object to."/>
