Dear Sirs

I write to object to this planning application.

I have close family who live down the road from the woods, into and out of which the applicant proposes to run skip lorries and other heavy equipment for a period of 33 years. I visit my family often and I cannot believe what is proposed.

This is such an unsuitable industrial operation for the location and area, which is characterised by quiet long-established woodland and twisting rural tracks and roads. The idea of families walking and cycling (or even in their cars) having to run the gauntlet of skip lorries on those tracks and roads just doesn't make any sense. The increased safety risk (and noise disturbance) would be huge.

Is there really any need for a new clay and waste facility like this, whether in the middle of the woods or indeed anywhere in the county? I can just about imagine one popping up on a brownfield site somewhere, but again only if the operator could demonstrate a need (rather than a simple desire to make money). As far as I understand it, there is in fact no need for additional clay in the county.

I would ask the Council to refuse this application.
