Comments	<p>Like many others I have enjoyed the peace and tranquillity of these woods for many years (more than 30). This application proposes to destroy this peaceful site and the proposals do not fit with the public access over the public paths and bridleways. The level of traffic would make access for walking hazardous.</p> <p>The area is blessed with great wildlife and plants and if this scheme were to go ahead much of this wildlife would be lost.</p> <p>The public highway access to this site has several pinch points, two low bridges which are narrow and stretches that require careful driving when passing larger vehicles. Access onto the A281 Guildford to Horsham road is difficult due to the angle of entry to the south.</p> <p>Along Loxwood road several houses are close to the road and the frequency of the large trucks will have significant detrimental affect to the residents of these properties.</p> <p>The extraction of clay to create a large hole to be filled with waste cannot be the best way to dispose of waste in the 21st century.</p>
