| Comments           | <p>I object on the following grounds:</p> <p><b>Need</b></p> <p>There does not appear to be a proven need for more clay or for more waste recycling sites of this type in the county.</p> <p><b>Safety and Location</b></p> <p>This is a very unsuitable area being sited along a country lane used by cyclists and horseriders. The road is narrow with bends and changes in gradient which make overtaking dangerous. The junction with the A281 presents further hazards. Lorries and pedestrians sharing the same track in the woods is not safe.</p> <p><b>Loss of amenity</b></p> <p>The layby is well used by walkers, especially dog walkers when other paths are muddy<br/>The whole area of Pallinghurst Woods is peaceful and tranquil, a place where you can hear birdsong, and this will be completely changed by the noise of lorries coming in and out regularly, generators and machinery.</p> <p><b>Ancient woodland</b></p> <p>As the name suggests this is not something that can be replaced.</p> |
