Comments	<p>There are many reasons to object to this dreadful application however major issues of note are impact on the local environment, increased traffic movement and negative consequences on the local communities.</p> <p>Increased HGV traffic will continue to put pressure on the areas already poor and over used roads whilst also increased roadside pollution for people who live close to access roads. In terms of the environment the pit and waste site will destroy one of the areas most natural sites, destroying an ancient woodland which so many local use for recreational activities.</p> <p>However, the main reason for this application to not proceed is the fact it simply does not fit in with either National or local policy making the destruction of a natural habitat unnecessary. Where housing and other developments are sometimes encouraged by local and National policies this proposal is certainly not. Local mineral policy clearly states West Sussex has a 25 year supply of clay meaning further extraction does not seem to be required. But perhaps more importantly National government policy states that waste sites should be mainly situated on brownfield Sites. The Pallinghurst woods are not this.</p> <p>What should be clear is the fact this proposal is no way suitable or needed and the council should do the right and reject this application.</p>
