Comments	<p>Dear Sir/Madam,</p> <p>I have lived in this beautiful rural area for over 15 years and personally I think it should have been part of the South Downs National park as it has nature in abundance.</p> <p>I therefore completely reject this application for a clay pit that will blight the area for over 25 years with highly intrusive noise, light, dust and traffic pollution.</p> <p>This is to say nothing of the habitat destruction and loss to the area, my children would regularly walk in the forest with my wife & I and this would not be possible with HGV moving backwards and forwards.</p> <p>In terms of safety, there is a severe highway safety issue from HGVs entering & exiting the Loxwood Road/A281 junction at Bucks Green. The road is just 5.1m wide at its narrowest point and 5.5m along most of its length and meeting a HGV along the road will be dangerous and cause congestion with any obstruction such as tractors, combines and lorries for local nurseries.</p> <p>These are my main objections and I understand the need for clay is already met as there are three sites with 25 years supply of clay and one with 24 years, therefore the national and local level clay requirements are met.</p> <p>Yours faithfully</p> <p>Mr Stephen Jelley</p>
