Comments	<p>I have been walking in Pallingshurst Wood for the last 20 years and this planning permission will completely destroy the tranquillity and natural beauty of the woods. I am objecting to this planning permission based on the following reasons:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Loss of public footpaths2. Destruction of a beautiful areas of woodland3. There is no compelling evidence that there is a legitimate need for clay in this area, with the council stating that there are more than 25 years of clay reserves available.4. There is no requirement for a waste site in West Sussex as there are other more suitable sites within West Sussex5. The impact in terms of noise and light pollution on the wildlife, including protected species such as the Barbastelle Bat and badgers will be immense6. Developments of this type should not be on greenfield sites (such as Pallingshurst Wood) but should be sited on brownfield sites or within built-up areas.7. The building proposed situated within unspoilt woodland will bring both light and environmental pollution due to the plant equipment, generators and vehicle movement.8. This contravenes all Government policy including the Government's support of Cop 26 which has a number of goals including 1) to adapt and protect communities and natural habitats 2) curtail deforestation9. The increase in traffic on local country roads will be considerable, which are not suitable for the proposed 42 HGV movements .
