I object to this application because of the damage it will do to the environment of the area. Though it is claimed not to directly damage ancient woodland it does lie within an ancient woodland complex which has a rich and diverse history, reflected in its rich and diverse biodiversity. Habitat will be removed and, more crucially, interconnectivity between habitats will be broken. Significant disturbance to flora and fauna, some of which is protected by law, will be inevitable. The claim by the company that the proposal will deliver net biodiversity gain simply serves to indicate the weakness in biodiversity gain measures. There must be far more appropriate places to consider for clay extraction and the point that this site is being considered at all indicates the wider problem of the unsustainable level of development being proposed throughout Sussex."/>
