I object to the above planning application on two counts.

1. I have lived in Loxwood for nearly 40 years and have always enjoyed walking in the woodland. The peace and tranquility, the fauna and flora, rare butterflies, spectacular bluebell woods, rare orchids and the ancient trees. Always liked to see horses on the bridleways and other like minded walkers. This will be destroyed as soon as HGV trucks move in and also the distance noise will be heard all too easily in parts of Loxwood.

2. The road from Loxwood, Station Road, to Bucks Green is no more than a country lane with several bends and quite narrow in places. It is already a much more dangerous road than it was as it carries more traffic than it did. It is certainly not suitable for HGV trucks and already gets dangerous potholes which we have to avoid until they are dealt with. If lorries come to Loxwood I would like to point out the school in Nicholsfield. How dangerous for children being dropped off and picked up - it is difficult for the ordinary motorist to get up and down Station Road at this time. Plus a health centre in Farm Close which generates traffic. Where are the suitable routes for these HGV trucks to take. The answer is none, the A281 is congested as it is and getting worse all the time.
