OBJECTION - Planning Application Number WSCC/030/21

My name is [REDACTED]. I am an 84 year old resident of Rudgwick at the address above. I have lived here for over 30 years. Over the years, as a keen walker, with my late husband and our dog, I have enjoyed the peace and tranquillity provided by the wonderful Pallinghurst Woods and would wish this beautiful environment to be maintained for generations to come rather than being devastated by unnecessary and unsuitable development.

I wish to object to this planning application in the strongest possible way and on the following grounds:

1. The location, on a greenfield site and in the heart of ancient and veteran woodland, is totally unsuitable for this development;
2. In an area where there are no other buildings, proposing a facility which has a footprint about the size of 5-6 tennis courts and roughly 1.5 times the height of a 2 storey house, is entirely out of keeping with the surroundings;
3. The noise impact from heavy machinery and heavy vehicles 5-6 days a week will impact the surrounding area for miles around, and is proposed in an area where the only sound each day is birdsong;
4. The pollution and destruction caused to this pristine environment and to the flora and fauna of the area, over the lifetime of the operation, will never be recovered
5. The increased volume of HGV traffic is not sustainable on the local roads to and from the site and in the surrounding villages. It presents a very significant increased safety risk, to pedestrians, cyclists, horse riders and other vehicle users.

I would strongly urge West Sussex County Council to reject this planning application.
