I am objecting to this application due to its impact on the natural environment. I am a nature lover and there are many mature trees on this site which have potential roost features for bats - I believe these will be amongst the first to be felled. There are 4 threatened bats on this site. The Barbastelle Bat is an international European Protected species and is rare in Sussex. This development will have a major impact on local wildlife because their habitat will be taken away. We quite often see Buzzards in the woods which used to be in decline but which we are now seeing a rise in their numbers.
