This a peaceful rural location of farmland and woodland, which provides positive physical and mental well-being to those who live, work and relax in the area. This area includes well established hedges and ancient woodland which is home to many species of plant and animal life that if destroyed could not be replaced including a number of rare and protected bats. There are live badger sets in the proposed access route, what would happen to them?
