Comments	<p>Following the amended application by Loxwood Claypits/ The Danhash family , I wish to object insomuch as their plans to build a brickworks,if they get permission for the waste recycling and waste burying is an additional future threat to the wild life in this area . Forestry traffic and log stacking is already operating too close to the badger sett and the their future if this plan is passed is likely to be terminal .</p> <p>Secondly, the access and use of barriers across a popular bridleway and footpath , has no validity and no information as to the safe control of traffic is given. The application terms that state the HGV's must have 'unhindered access 'to the Loxwood Road which by definition means that the safety and benefit of the bridleway is less important than the profits of a private company.</p> <p>Lastly, it is well known by all locals and by visitors, cyclists and many others who come to this location for exercise, that Loxwood Road is a quiet , twisting road where at any time , there may be a horse , tractor or other obstacle on the road and therefore care must be taken . These people, though they may live outside the area , have a voice and must be heard . It is not acceptable for Loxwood Claypits to insist that objections from more than 5 miles radius are not valid , as they blocked in their webinars also, in order to limit public knowledge and ability to object .</p> <p>Fundamentally , it is a multimillion pound project to profit private individuals for 33 years , at the detriment of thousands of folk of all ages and generations of children to come .</p>
