Comments	<p>I vehemently object to this ridiculous planning applications on the grounds listed below</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. WSCCC have already stated in the past that we/they do not require anymore clay for brick making as we have enough for 25 years2. We are meant to be planting trees to absorb are CO2 and not cutting down a swathe of trees to then lay tarmac for HGV to destroy what is left of the surrounding habitat .3. Destroying an area that is inhabited by various animals that depend on this area for there lives,4. To destroy and area used by many of the public not just locals but others from out of the area who come and walk there dogs in the quite and tranquil surrounding.5. The danger that will arise with HGV'S using the Lowood road of the A281 which is a country lane where in places according to WSCC road signage is only 2.2 meters wide therefore not enough space for two vehicles to pass let alone two HGV'S which will then cause an accident and possible jams while trying to reverse so enabling vehicles to pass.6. This is a country lane where in the majority of the road there is no foot path so causing danger to life for any pedestrian who may be walking down it and the HGV therefore unable to give a wide enough clearance to pass said person7. This lane is also used by horse riders and cyclist and under the new Laws coming out how is the HGV going to be able to abide by the law and give that horse and rider 2 meters clearance when passing as parts of this country lane is only 2,2 meters wide and any cyclist 1.5 meters when these vehicles themselves are over 2 meters wide8. There will also be a great problem with light and noise pollution in an ancient woodland.9 There will be a serious accident waiting to happen and this will be on WSCC conscience due to the number of now 64 increased from 33 HGV's using this lane.10.
