Comments	<p>I am 86 years old and have lived on Loxwood Road for over 50 years and I am devastated by the implications of this proposal and the effect it will have on traffic on the road, making it so much more dangerous for everyone as the road is just too narrow for those big lorries - this is a residential country area, not an industrial zone!</p> <p>The pathway is very narrow here and hazardous walking alone it at the best of times due the volume and speed of traffic, we get few large lorries along here, but it is frightening and much of this road does not have footpath so pedestrians are forced to walk in the road, if you agree to allow all these big lorries which will all drive too fast, there will be accidents and deaths here The school bus stops outside my house for collecting children, no lorries would get past it, thus causing more congestion, chaos and danger - my neighbour had his work van rear ended not long ago and traffic really struggled to get past , larger vans could not get past, there was not space for them to turn around, cars lined up, it was chaos.</p> <p>We also have lots of cyclists and horses using this road on a daily basis, I dread to think of the possible accidents, suffering and harm all those big lorries will cause</p> <p>I have walked in the woods with my various dogs for most of those 50 + years, it is a place of peace and tranquility, a place to relax, recharge and is essential to mental health and wellbeing for all who use it and people come from further away to visit the woods, they are used by walkers, cyclists, horses, local schools and youth groups use them for educational purposes, search and rescue dogs use the woods as a training ground for their vital work in saving lives - all this would be lost forever if you allow this dreadful development to go ahead</p> <p>It doesnt matter what fancy name you give it, this proposal is a landfill site - there are already plenty of landfill and recycling sites in the area, we dont need any more and Im not convinced there is suitable demand for the clay either</p> <p>There will be absolutely no benefits from this proposed development to the local area or residents - we have to be subjected to the noise, dust, fumes, pollution and the resulting adverse effects on our health, increase in danger, traffic congestion, loss of the beautiful ancient woodland area</p> <p>What about the destruction of the ancient woodlands? the harm to the delicate eco system, the loss of untold amounts of wildlife, insects, plants, trees, the stunning acres of bluebell woods? there is NO development that justifies this, this is being done purely for profit and its wrong!!!</p> <p>You on the council have a duty beyond the obvious, a duty to future generations, a duty to conserve our beautiful countryside, not to be part of its destruction forever, you have duty to support the views of and to protect those whom you serve, YOU HAVE A DUTY TO REJECT THIS PROPOSAL IN ITS ENTIRETY!!!!</p>
