Comments	<p>I strongly object to this application based on my previous objections and to re enforce my objections .</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1.The WSCC Mineral and Waste policies have been put in place to protect out community and environment from inappropriate development. The applicant does not agree with the policies that have been put in place therefore does not want to comply.</li><li>2. There is not the demand for clay that the applicants claims as per my previous objection. The applicant gives no supporting evidence to their claim. The applicant does not name who the customers are for the clay. Brickmaking companies are now consolidating.</li><li>3. The applicants new Bat survey does not cover the wider woodland which will be affected by the applicants development and the impact on the rare Barbastelle bat travelling to their foraging areas which can cover a large distance. There has been a decline of 41% of species due to loss of habitat due to development and a Biodiversity Emergency was declared in 2019. This application would add to the decline.</li><li>4. Safety issues have not been addressed regarding constant movement of HGV lorries which will be sharing the PROW and lanes/roads with walkers some with children and dogs, plus horses and cyclists. This is an area of natural beauty and tranquillity which has been enjoyed for many years by the surrounding community. The impact of loss of amenity, noise, dust and peacefulness has not been addressed.</li><li>5.The constant vibration of HGV lorries (estimated 33 a day) passing by listed properties and the damage which could be caused to these properties and the impact on their residents plus the use of very narrow unsuitable lanes and cost of repair has not been addressed.</li><li>6.Transport consultants have advised that this application could be underestimating by 200% the amount HGV vehicle movement along the Loxwood Road and at the very dangerous junction on to the 281 plus the at the access to the woodland area. They have also advised the visibility at the site entrance is far less than the minimum the Applicant is saying.</li><li>7. There is no evidence to support the need for additional material recycling in West Sussex.</li></ol> <p>I object completely to this application and the further information added by the applicant.
