Fundamentally our local road network is not set up for this sort of industrial transportation. As you can see from my attached photograph, there simply is not enough room for two HGV's to pass each other along most of the road. The road is simply too narrow. The lorries will not be passing through Loxwood so instead will be queuing in Bucks Green to get onto the A281. The local buses have trouble enough navigating this complicated turn.

I ride my horse round these bridleways and roads and if I am travelling west, towards Loxwood I have genuine fear about my visibility on those bends.

I also have concerns about the safety of myself and my horse - is there boundary security fencing around the site?

The application proposes to put a very large 1400 square foot industrial building and 15 acres for extraction on a rural site for the manufacture of a product which is adequately supplied by large UK brickworks. Small brickworks such as West Hoathly tend not to be commercially viable.

We are at a crucial stage of needing to promote biodiversity - this scheme would undermine it in an area important to wildlife.

We live in a largely safe, rural environment; we ride, cycle, walk and run on the local roads and in the woods, my children catch the bus on Loxwood Road. I know that one of the jobs of the County Council is to protect the community and I have every faith that West Sussex County Council will protect my family and those in my community.
