Comments	<p>This would be absolutely devastating for the wildlife of this ancient woodland. The noise and fumes created by excavators and HGV vehicles etc would have a significant negative impact on the environment, its wildlife and also local residents.</p> <p>One of the many attractions of this woodland is the fact that it is a large expanse of countryside with no roads crossing through, making it an extremely safe environment for people and animals to enjoy without traffic danger.</p> <p>The main track that the HGV's will take cuts straight through the woods with other footpaths criss crossing over frequently, it would be impossible to make this area safe so that the general public can continue to use the surrounding woodland.</p> <p>The access to the lay-by where the clay pit entrance will be is on a sharp bend. The idea of lorries coming in and out of this lay-by is extremely dangerous and will undoubtedly block the parking area for all existing users.</p> <p>The vastly increased HGV traffic will have a severe detrimental impact on the local villages in particular Tismans Common and Bucks Green. Loxwood Road is not suitable for this intended amount of HGV's it is way too windy and narrow in parts. Access for the HGV's on to the A281 from the Loxwood Road at Bucks Green is yet another severe safety issue at an already very congested junction!</p>
