The application is for the extraction of clay and construction material recycling facility at Pallinghurst Woods, Loxwood Road, Loxwood. Pre application discussions with the applicant took place in November 2020. Further information in the form of a highway report addendum has been provided.

Visibility

No updated information has been provided to reflect non adjusted speed surveys or a departure from standard applied for rather a restatement of case which is not accepted. As per my previous response:

ATCs have been undertaken to the east and west of the site access in June 2020 whilst this was during a Covid lockdown the use of the speed data is acceptable. The transport technical note has provided 85th% speeds based on a wet weather adjustment. As detailed within the pre application advice the wet weather adjustment should not be applied (in line with the requirements of CA 185) It is noted that the splays of 2.4m x

105m and 2.4m x 150m are achievable but would not meet DMRB requirements. No departure for standard has been applied for.

Designers Response

A designers response has been provided (dated 18th of March 2021) however is not in the requested GG119 Appendix F format

https://www.standardsforhighways.co.uk/prod/attachments/710d4c33-0032-4dfb-8303-17aff1ce804b and as such does not allow for agreed actions to be developed.

Whilst it is noted that the designer agrees with auditors suggested action on the five issues raised, I would raise concern about the recommended action of A.3.3 and the suitability of warning signs to reduce speeds to an acceptable level to provide sufficient forward visibility.

Staff Trip Information

No additional details have been provided however the planning statement indicates the site would generate 12 jobs.

Westbound HGC tracking or clarification on planning statement 4.3

It as been confirmed that all HGVs would be routed to and from the south-east to the junction of Loxwood Road with the A281 at Bucks Green. This

Details on layby parking, any restrictions proposed and HGV routing on exit.

A plan ref NJC-002 details the swept path of a HGV and details that it would not effect the existing parking provision. HGV routing on exit could be controlled within the HGV routing agreement.
