Comments   
'Achieving sustainable development' runs throughout the NPPF and requires 'social', 'economic' and 'environmental' considerations to be taken into account. Any fossil fuel development at Broadford Bridge is by definition not sustainable. The adverse effects of climate change are long since settled in any real scientific sense, and any impact on climate change is a legitimate reason for local government authorities to refuse these types of applications.
