The above co-ordinates will lead you to the cache located at the entrance to the well-site. There is NOT access to the site. There is a good view of the 'nodding donkeys'.

Start the walk by following the blue public bridleway sign. Do NOT go through the gated roadway. There's a fairly steep climb to the first cache. Fallen branches have made it a bit more tricky to reach the cache but it is still accessable and in the original hiding place.




