We are currently collating some additional information on rig equipment relating to the proposed development at Wisborough Green which we need before we can review the design changes and any consequential impacts on the ES. Therefore we are not yet in a position to submit the Regulation 22 Addendum as it would be sensible to wait until the planning documents and design can be reviewed in parallel before we conclude our submission. We have otherwise made some positive design changes which will be fully documented in the forthcoming Addendum.
