re: **Planning Application No: WSCC/083/13/KD**

Proposal: The installation of a well and associated infrastructure, including access road and soil bunds, for the drilling of a vertical borehole and contingent horizontal borehole from the same well for the exploration, testing and evaluation of hydrocarbons for a temporary period of three years.

Location: Land south of Boxal Bridge, Northup Field, Wisborough Green, West Sussex, RH14 0DD.

Applicant: Celtique Energie Weald Ltd.

The Parish Council is extremely concerned about the proposed routing of HGV lorries accessing the site via the A.272 from the direction of Petworth as in order to turn left in Wisborough Green off the A.272 it will be necessary for these large vehicles to go on the wrong side of the road in order to get round the corner, which is considered to be a very dangerous manoeuvre.

The Parish Council would also like to bring to your particular attention that in these days when drivers follow their 'Satnavs' that there is a danger that these vehicles could well use even less suitable roads to access the site.

For the above reasons the Parish Council would appreciate it if you could kindly arrange that the Parish Council is consulted at the time that discussions take place regarding the Traffic Management Plan, for no other reason that the Parish Council would then be in a position to reassure residents that their views have been taken into consideration.
