The site has an existing vehicular access onto the A283 serving the oilfield. The use has notably been in operation for a number of years. The information submitted with the current application indicates that the site will continue to generate a very low level of vehicle movements and the number of movements is in any case capped to no more than 22 HGV movements per day. The Highway Authority is not aware of any highway safety issues that have arisen through the operation of the site. On that basis, there is no evidence to suggest that the extension of time would give rise to any highway issues.

No highway objection would be raised.
