Thank you for the opportunity to comment on Planning Application WSCC/008/18/BN – Retention of Lidsey Oil Site

The proposed development does not indicate any impact on public rights of way as no changes to the localised footpath network is proposed. It is noted that the application for the proposed development identifies:

- No change to vehicular movements to / from the site is proposed and the number of vehicle journeys will be no more than that originally suggested in the 2006 planning application.
- There would be minimal visual impact as the closest public footpath is directly south of the well pad, but only gives transient views through the access gate.
- Although the PROW is directly south of the well pad, people cannot access the site due to fencing surrounding the well pad. The site is also screened by mature trees and grassed bunds.
- There is signage to alert users of footpaths adjacent to the site of the presence of HGV traffic. It is also noted that pedestrians have rights of way over traffic travelling to and from the site.

Therefore WSCC PROW does not raise objection to the proposal.
