Dear Sirs,
I write to object to the above proposal
to establish an Incinerator at Wealden Brickworks,
Langhurstwood Road, Horsham W. Sussex.

My principal objections are - the proposed size of
this industrial plant, the fact that on the
proposed scale materials for disposal/recycling
will be imported to a district already providing
service for the locally produced waste, thus adding
an unnecessary heavy goods traffic to roads
already bearing an out of area traffic load for
industry, construction and Gatwick Airport, and
light pollution from safety illumination (air traffic)
on building taller than the brickworks on site.

This proposal works against the interests
of Horsham residents, and the wider West Sussex

population already seeing major additions in construction and domestic building over an area formerly attractive countryside, a constant increase in traffic in roads never designed for modern vehicles in country areas adjacent to the main A24 / A29 / A281 / A264 network.

Converting North Horsham into a densely industrialised and residential area with yet more pressure of infrastructure build-up is a much mistaken policy. Importing waste into the area only serves to add to the problems already caused by developments on greenfield sites attracting an undesirable increase in population
