Re: Horsham Incinerator Plan

Ref: WSCC / 015 / 18 / NH

Last year plans for a proposed incinerator near us in Rusper were rejected. We hear Britanniaeast has submitted new plans which we write to comment on and hope will again be rejected!

We centre our concerns on the likely transportation of waste across county borders, polluting our air with  $\text{CO}_2$  and NOx emissions. Incineration increases  $\text{CO}_2$  levels, damaging our health and the rural environment.

We believe too many incinerator plants available may in fact correlate with decreased recycling by individuals. MPs are now aware of this.

Also, the existing chimney is 28m tall, the proposed incinerator building will be 36m tall with a 95m chimney. All of this

is unacceptable in a largely rural area N. of the A264.

Additionally, the World Health Organization advises that areas near a waste incinerator should not be populated yet this unwanted development will be adjacent to the N. Horsham Development with the plume heading over nearby housing and countryside.

We sincerely hope you will listen to the many voices raising concern which are in united opposition to a plan which would (if allowed) deeply effect the life, health, well-being and safety of human life and animals.

The application by Britannia West to build an incinerator must be refused for the above reasons.
