The development would have an unacceptable impact on eight counts.

- The proposed development at the Former Wealden Brickworks, together with other permitted development both North and South of Horsham, cumulatively would have adverse effects.
- The 2,500 additional households foreseen in the nearby North Horsham Development would be deprived of any input to the process of an approval which will adversely affect their environment.
- It has yet to be demonstrated that the facility is required to maintain net self-sufficiency for the management, transference, recycling, and treatment of wastes generated within West Sussex.
- It has also yet to be demonstrated that incineration would have fewer adverse effects than landfill.
- Evidence can be provided of the potential availability of more than adequate landfill sites within the county.

The proposed development would also have an unacceptable impact on

- the landscape,
- visual amenity, and
- public health.
