

TOPOGRAPHY AND ROUTES

- The boundary of the site is shown here in red. The contours which are at 2m intervals illustrate the detailed landform of the Northern Vales which is essentially natural except for the gravel workings immediately to the north of the site.
- The vertical difference between the highest contour shown here is 110 AOD and lowest contour at 42 AOD is 68m.
- The proposed 95m tall stack is significantly higher than the vertical range of the existing landform shown here. This will make its impact very significant.
